CONTINUING CARE SPEECH THERAPY BURSARY PROGRAM APPLICATION

Shoreline Speech Therapy is currently accepting applications for the Speech Therapy Bursary Program. This program is for residents of long term care facilities in the Dartmouth and Halifax area who experience barriers to accessing treatment for a communication disorder:

- (a) inability or significant hardship to travel to service locations
- (b) financial barriers (those with only \$500 of insurance coverage may still apply)

The bursary includes:

- (a) full communication assessment
- (b) block of treatment (up to a maximum of 6 months; depends on resident's needs)
- (c) treatment provided at the individual's place of residence
- (d) all assessment and treatment materials

There is currently one spot for each of the following:

- (a) person with aphasia
- (b) person with Parkinson's disease

Process:

1. Contact Pamela Coulter.

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2. Provide a brief letter from a social worker, registered nurse, or physician familiar with the resident and vouching for existing barriers to access of S-LP services (public or private).
3. If you are contacting Shoreline on behalf of a resident and you are not their substitute decision maker, you must have the consent of the resident.
4. Candidacy for treatment will be determined during assessment by the S-LP.
